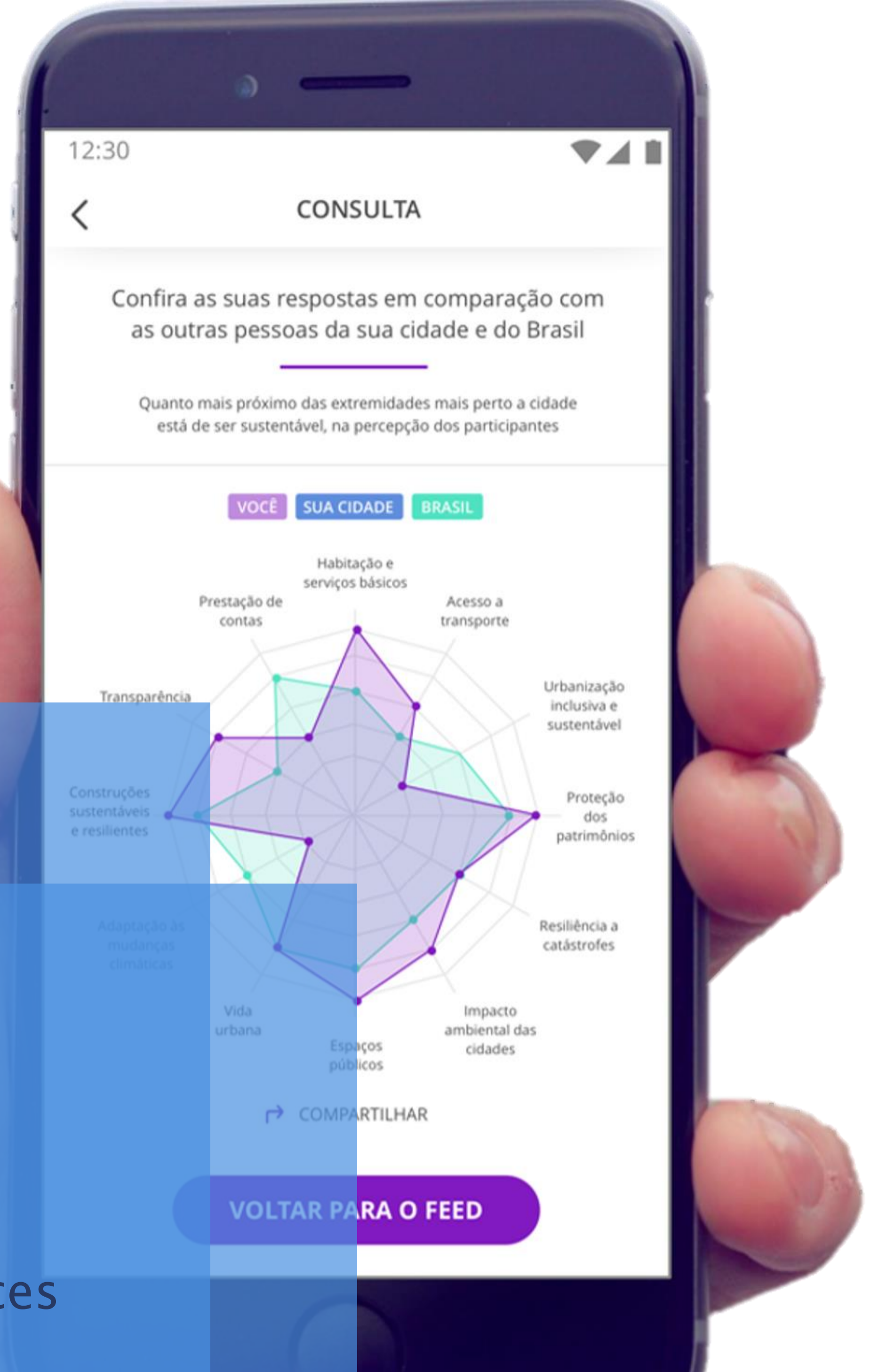

The story behind the consultation

The consultation was developed progressively and tested during workshops held in Trujillo and Niterói.

The tool was first tested as a group exercise to check the view of the different cities and their achievement of SDG11.



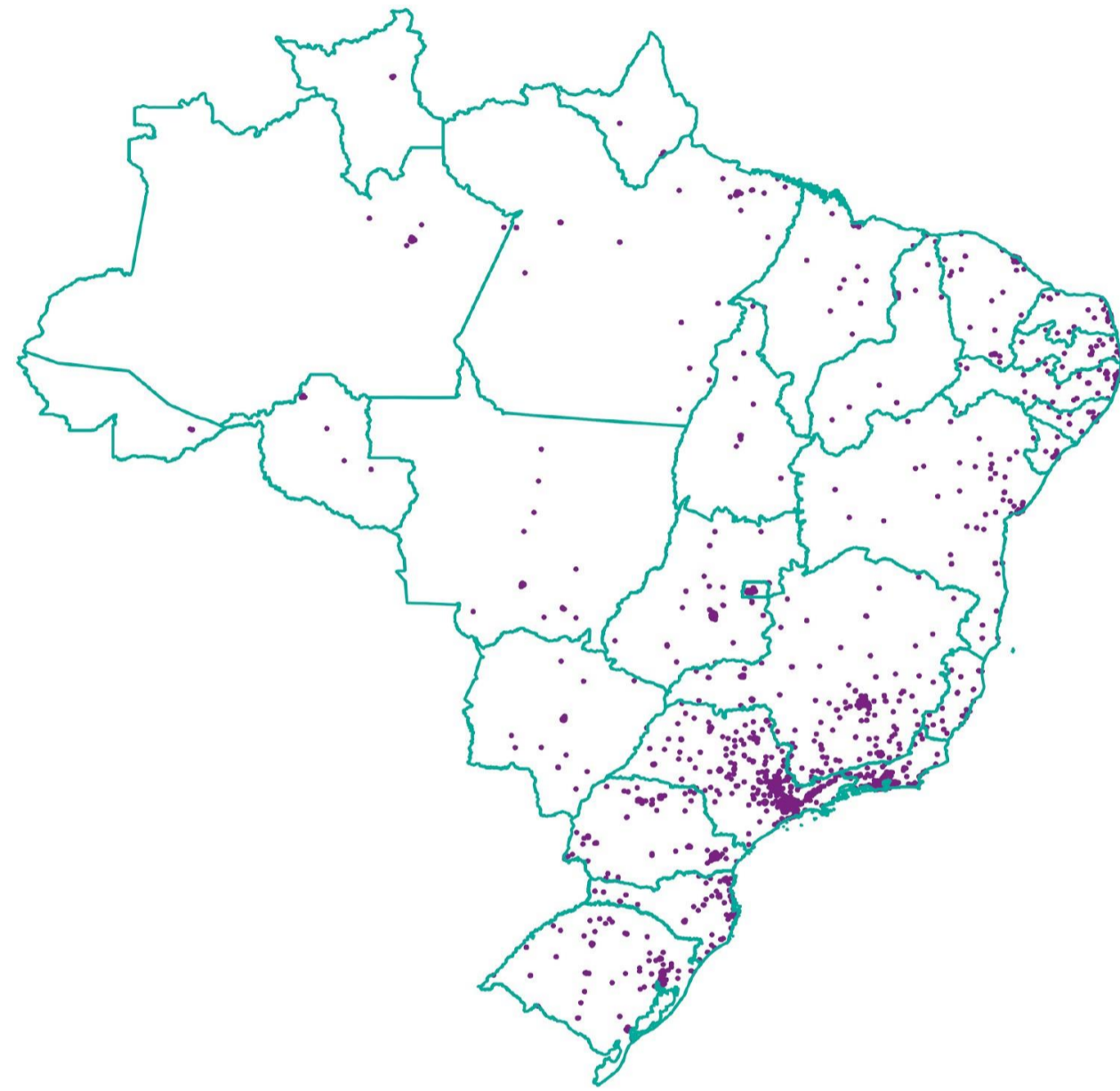
This exercise was later transformed into an excel tool which provided participants with an automatized visualization of SDG 11 indicators and their answers from the online questionnaire



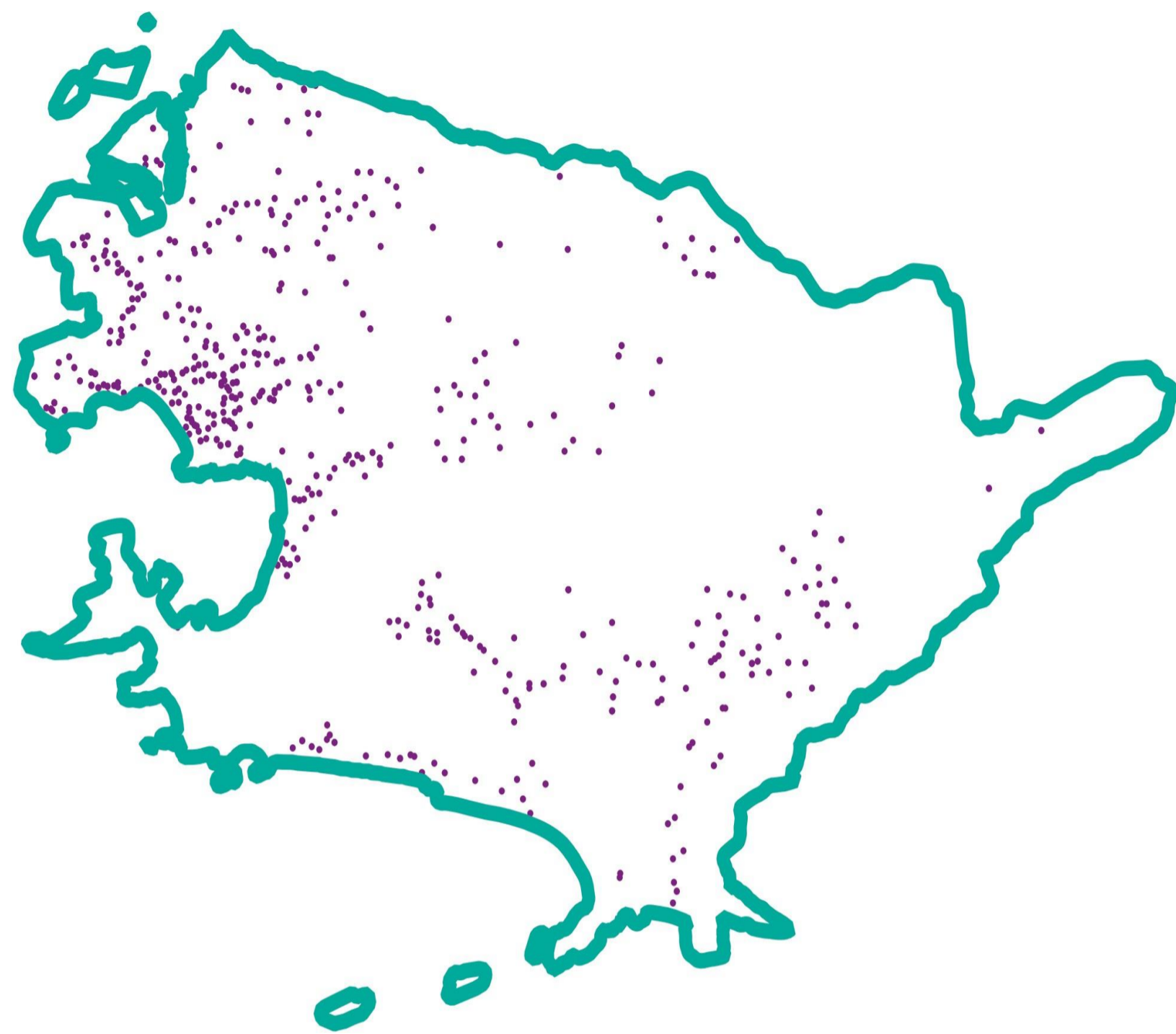
The results



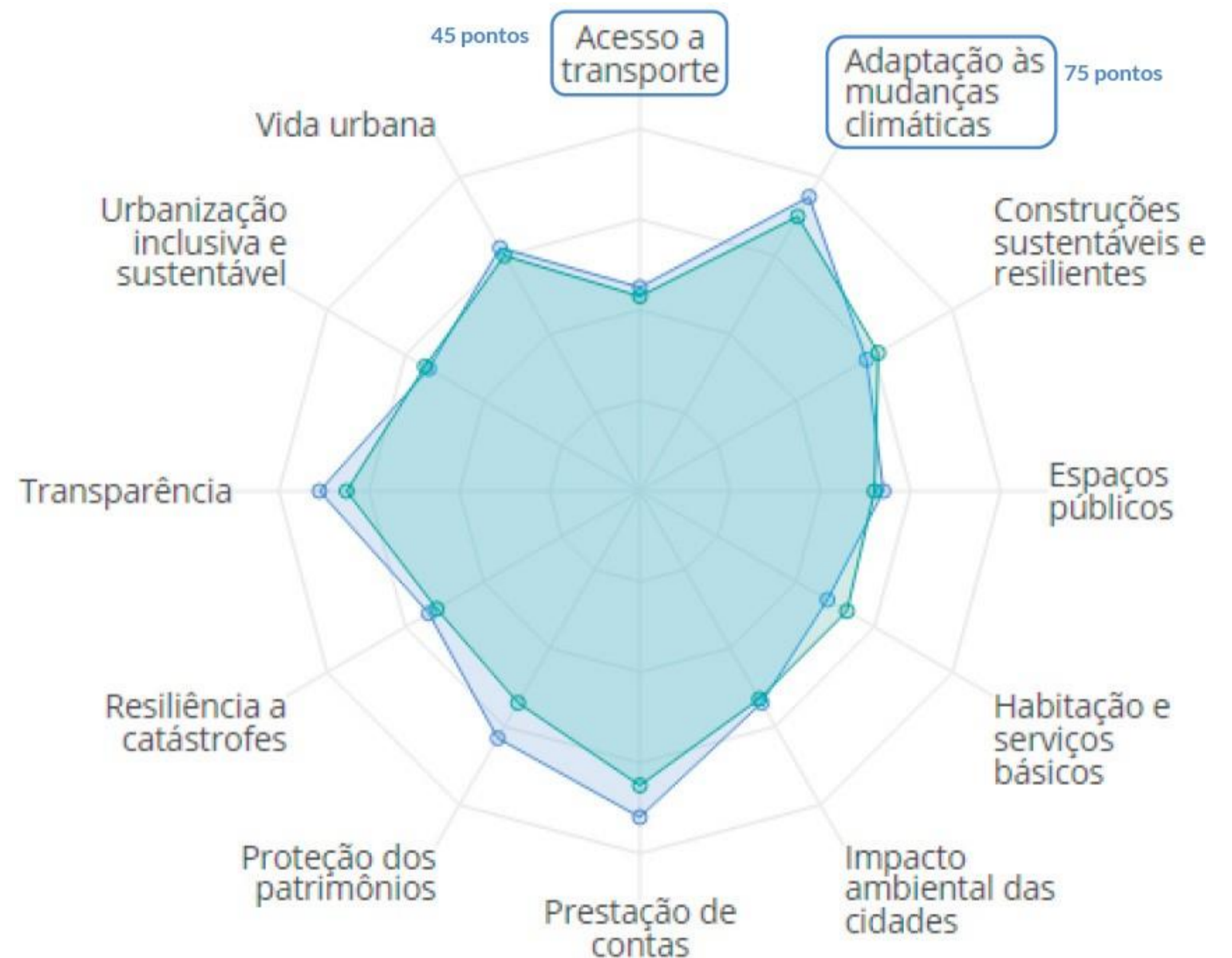
Brazil National average

Niteroi's map



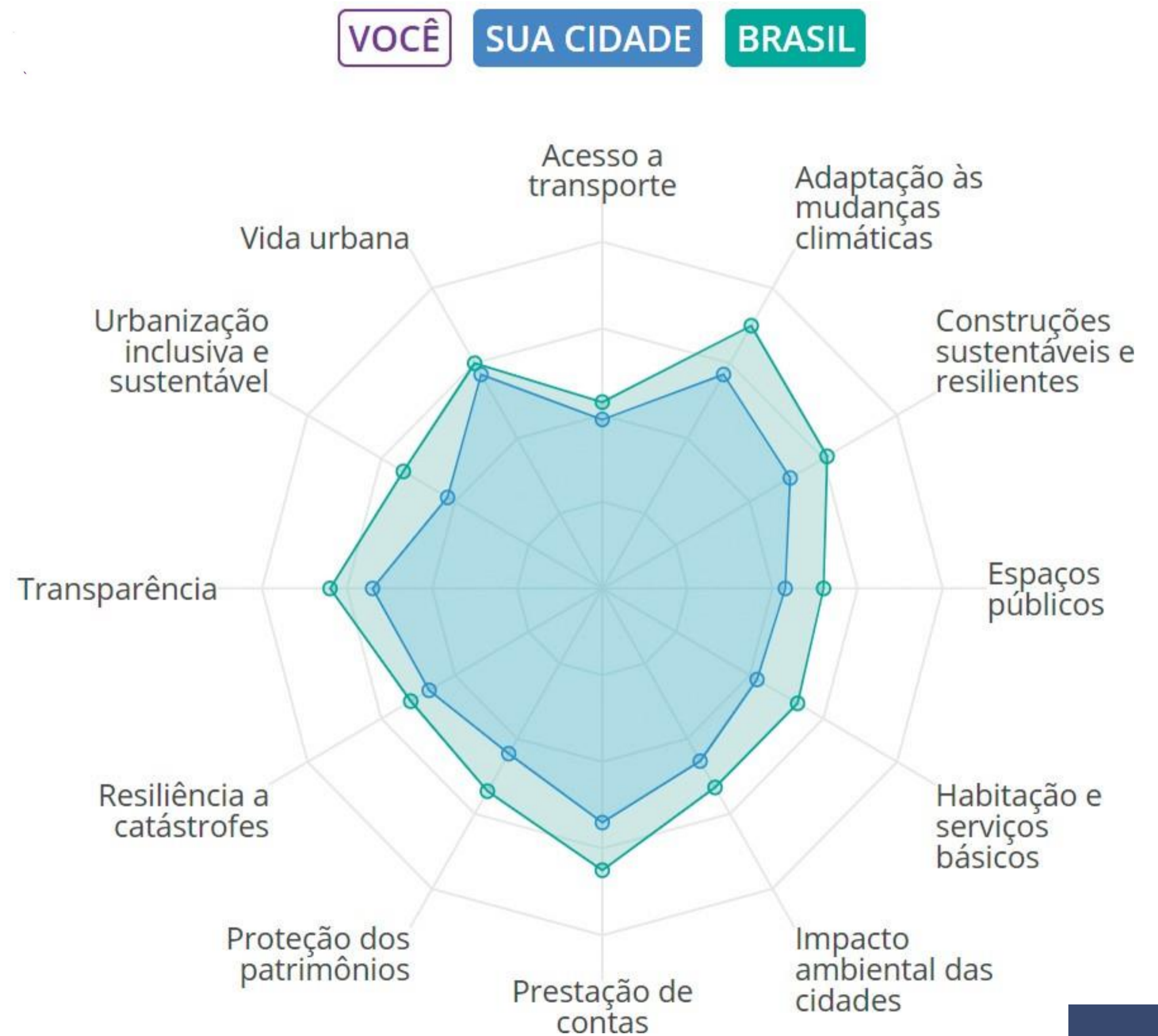
Niteroi results

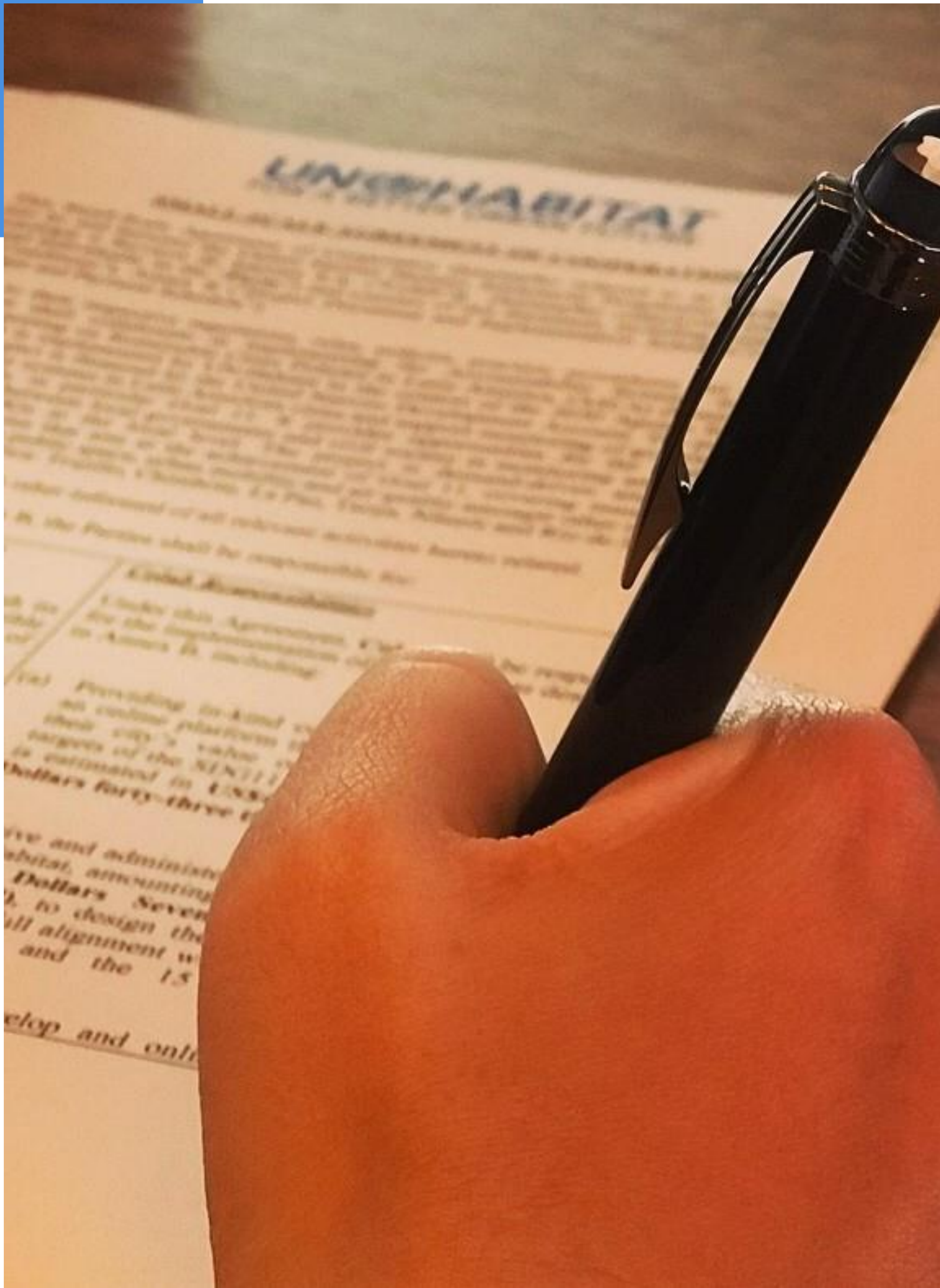
